Dear Parent/Carer,

For several years now, SJB has run an optional residential trip to London for Year 6 pupils in the Summer Term. The children who have attended this trip have remembered it as one of the highlights of primary school.

It is our intention to run this trip again for our current Year 6 class in June/July 2017. As with last year's trip, we offer a three-day excursion to include a weekend (i.e. leaving school early on Friday morning, returning on Sunday evening). As with the previous five years' trips our accommodation will be **Thameside YHA**, a youth hostel nicely situated in a quiet residential area on the south bank of the Thames. We will travel by coach.

The dates for the proposed trip are **Friday 30th June until Sunday 2nd July 2017**.

The itinerary has yet to be finalized, but is likely to include the following:

- Warner Bros. Studio Tour 'The Making of Harry Potter'
- The London Eye
- River Cruise
- Dinner at Planet Hollywood
- A West End show ('Matilda')
- The National Gallery
- The Natural History Museum
- Tour of the Houses of Parliament

We have a provisional booking with YHA Thameside.

We are anticipating a price of around £260, per child, although this amount is dependent on the number of pupils attending and our final itinerary; as these have yet to be finalized, we cannot give a definitive figure. We would encourage all pupils to experience this opportunity. If you have any concerns regarding funding this trip, please contact school to make an appointment to see Miss Pemberton.

















We are asking for an initial deposit of £30 to be paid by **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2016**. After payment of the initial deposit, parents/carers will be issued with a payment card, keeping a running total of payments made. Following the receipt of deposits we will set up a payment schedule for the remainder of the balance.

Please also note that by signing-up for and paying the initial deposit, parents/carers are committed to the trip. Only in exceptional cases, such as unexpected serious medical issue, will our insurance policy cover a cancellation. The school CANNOT cover the cost of a last minute change of heart.
