

Years 3 & 4 School Trip to Manchester: Thursday 19th October 2017

During the school holidays we planned an action-packed trip to Manchester this term.

- The Jewish Museum – as part of our RE studies for this term
- The National Football Museum – as part of our commitment to sports and healthy living
- The Imperial War Museum North – as part of our history curriculum

At the last minute (and after quite a lot of phone calls) we were very lucky to be able to reserve tickets for 'Joseph and His Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat' at the Palace Theatre in Manchester. This would be a fantastic opportunity for our children to see a proper West End quality musical.

The cost for the trip (including the theatre) would be £30.00 maximum. We need to confirm and pay for our theatre tickets next Monday so we are asking for a deposit of at least £15* by Monday 11th September. This is the main trip for years 3 and 4. Any other trips will be significantly less.

This is a voluntary contribution however we may have to cancel the theatre tickets if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions as this is obviously the most expensive part of the trip.

We are sorry that it means we are asking for money again after swimming payments but it would be a shame to miss such a good opportunity. The trip will be supported at a rate of about £10 per child if we attend the theatre and £5 per child if we visit the museums only. You will, of course, be able to pay the remainder in installments.

We will leave school around 8:00am and return after the show which starts at 7:30pm. We realise this is a really late night however we would love the children to have the experience of an evening performance of a play. Last year we had a similar late night and all the children coped really well.

We are currently shopping around for the best deal for coach travel and we will let you know the final price as soon as we can. We will write to you again soon with more information and a final price.
