**SUMMER RECYCLING CHALLENGE**

Can you recycle each of these 12 things before school starts again in September? It might be your own rubbish or you might find them as litter. \* = more details overleaf

 <b>Cans</b> - kerbside	 <b>Glass</b> - kerbside	 <b>Paper</b> - kerbside	 <b>Plastic bags*</b>
 <b>Crisp packets</b> collection box in Cut The Wrap	 <b>Plastic bottles, including milk bottles</b> - kerbside	 <b>Toothbrush / toothpaste*</b> collection box in Booths	 <b>Chocolate wrappers*</b> collection box in Cut The Wrap
 <b>Cardboard</b> - kerbside	 <b>Pens*</b> collection box in Ford Park cafe	 <b>Batteries</b> various collection boxes including Booths and Cut The Wrap	 <b>Paper cups*</b> - Costa

Plastic bags can be recycled in the wheelex bins in Booths and Leisure Centre recycling areas. Not just carrier bags, any of the following:

- plastic carrier bags
- plastic bread bags
- plastic cereal bags i.e. porridge oats (not inners from boxed cereals)
- plastic wrappers and ring joiners from multipacks of cans and plastic bottles
- plastic wrappers from toilet roll and kitchen roll packs
- plastic freezer bags
- bubble wrap
- plastic magazine and newspaper wrap (type used for home delivery only)
- thin bags used for fruit and veg at supermarkets
- low density polyethylene (LOPE) symbol, see right



REMEMBER THE WASTE HIERARCHY – REDUCE, REUSE, THEN RECYCLE AS THE LAST OPTION

Cut The Wrap is a zero waste shop located on Upper Brook Street in Ulverston. Please only take your recycling during opening hours. Tuesday – Saturday 10am – 5pm

Paper cups are usually lined with plastic and so can't be put in with your cardboard recycling. Costa accepts any brand and size of paper cup. Just hand them to a member of staff. If the cup says it's compostable or made with 'plants not plastic' just put in a bin.
