Dear Parent/Carer,

It was wonderful to have the whole school back yesterday and on the whole we had a successful day. It was really good to see the children enjoying their learning again with their whole class and they have responded really well to new routines. We hope they have come home with some positive stories and are ready to come back tomorrow.

Of course we had some teething problems and things we are still working on. Thank you to Mr Smith for helping us with the new school gate lock ;).

We had some feedback about possible concerns with shared boys/girls toilets. We have therefore changed the arrangements as it is important all our children feel comfortable and safe using the toilet facilities. Boys and girls are now using different toilet blocks. The blocks will be shared by year group bubbles. **However every year group has their own cubicle sink and washing resources to use** and we are working hard to avoid cross over in the blocks as far as possible. Year 1,2 and 3 boys are using an infant block. Ideally, we would like to have an additional toilet block, but at present we must work with what we have.

A few little requests to help us this end.

**Please** practise social distancing when waiting at the beginning and start of the day to minimise the risk of Covid19. This is very important to us. **Please** keep at least 1 metre apart and at least 2 metres where possible.

If you are collecting at 9am or 3.15pm, **please** avoid being around the gate areas at 8.45am and 3pm when other groups will be trying to leave.

**Please** make sure you book your child's lunch via Lunchshop. **Please** make sure your child has a coat as the weather is very changeable.
