Breakfast Club and After School Club will need to be booked via ParentPay 5 days in advance.

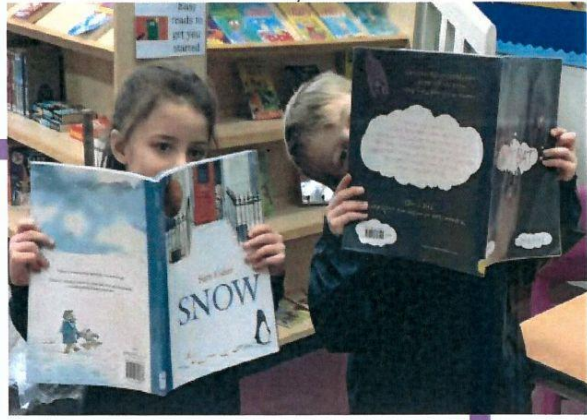
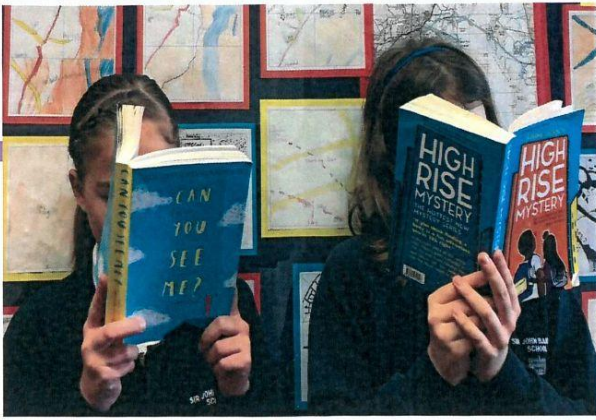
Children must only be dropped off at breakfast club if they are booked in. The administration team will ensure the Breakfast Club staff have a list of children booked in.
