Content

- SJB Long Term Plan details the art skills covered in each year group.
- SJB Long Term Plan ensures a steady progression of art skills from EYFS to Year 6.
- A wide range of art mediums are taught at SJB and skills in each area are built on yearly.
- All year groups study a different influential artist.



Teaching

- Art is taught through the development and progression of skills, that are revisited and built on, year on year.
- Art tasks link to foundation subjects and text illustrations .
- All year groups study a different artist.
- Visits from artists and cultural visits enrich our curriculum.



Teaching Key Points

- A range of examples for each skill/technique are discussed and appreciated.
- New art skills/techniques are modelled by an adult.
- Pupils are given time to practise and experiment with new skills
- Pupils are given time to explore new materials.
- Pupils combine the above to plan work.
- The completion process and finished pieces of work are reflected upon and evaluated.
- Where possible, sketch books are used to record the artistic process.
