School Uniform

Here's a little reminder of our current school uniform:

It is requested that children wear plain black trainers for school (preferable) or strong black shoes suitable for outdoor play and PE. Children can also have a plain black pair of plimsoles or shoes for indoor wear if they prefer.

A school PE kit is not required (to be reviewed in the Summer Term) Children will need a plain pair of jogging/PE trousers (dark grey, black or navy, in line with the uniform colours for trousers and skirts) These can be worn daily as part of the school uniform if preferred. Otherwise your child should wear jogging/PE trousers on PE days. We do not recommend skirts or tight trousers as these will prove uncomfortable during outdoor learning and play

We will be out in ALL weathers. Your child will require a waterproof jacket and easy to put on waterproof leggings (We can provide some waterproof clothing where required) The waterproof coat may be worn as a general coat and waterproof leggings should be brought in a labelled carrier bag or washable drawstring bag

School Uniform is

- School t-shirt
- School sweat-shirt
- School trousers or plain black/navy/grey PE trousers
- Plain Black trainers (or shoes suitable for active wear outside)
- Waterproof coat
 - Waterproof leggings that are easy to put on (some waterproof clothing is available in school. Please speak to the classteacher if required)

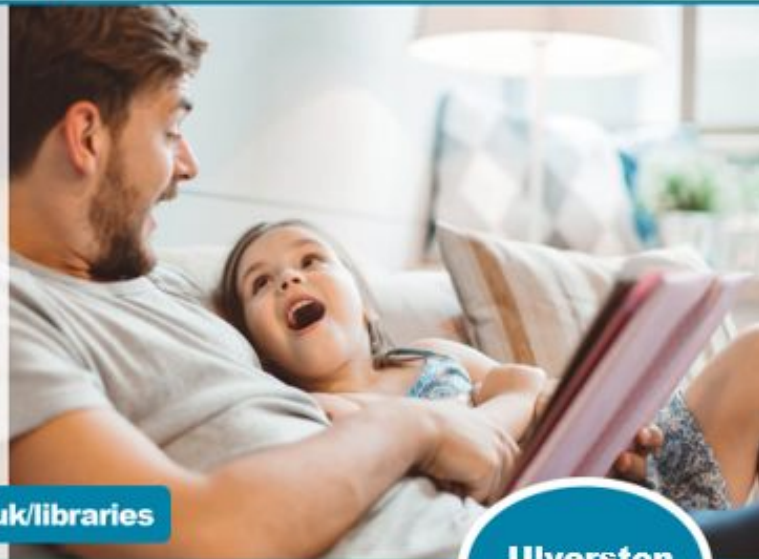
