In previous years Ulverston and the surrounding area schools attended Barrow Fire Station for a Junior Citizen event. Some parents may have attended this when they were in Year 6.

This year, Ulverston's Community Team have decided to do this themselves along with Fire & Rescue and partner agencies here at the Ulverston Blue Light Hub.

The aim is to teach the 10 and 11 year olds to identify potentially dangerous situations, providing advice on what to do and helping them learn valuable life skills to encourage responsible citizenship.

Each session covers:

- Fire Safety.
- First Aid.
- Online Safety.
- Drugs & alcohol.
- Safety on the Railways.
- Countryside Safety.
- Antisocial Behaviour.
- Knife Crime.
