Dear Parents/Carers

Robinwood Residential – Monday 19th January 2026 - Wednesday 21st January 2026

Just to let you know about the final arrangements for our Year 5 Residential. We would appreciate it if we could please have any outstanding payments by Friday 16th January. Please contact Miss Robinson or the office if you need support with the payments.

Please meet at SJB between **7.45am and 8am on Monday 19th January.**

Please find attached a kit list for Robinwood.

All medicines should be handed to a member of staff upon arrival at SJB, including travel sickness tablets. Please send your child with any **prescribed** medicine in a separate, named poly bag with clear, written instructions for administration. If your child is asthmatic and requires an inhaler for attacks, please make sure that they carry that with them in a pocket or bum-bag and that it has their name and school on it in case it is 'misplaced'. If your child has been prescribed a new medicine prior to the trip, a form will need to be filled in - please contact the office.

The coach will be leaving as soon as it has been packed and after the children have been registered at approx. 8:15am.

We suggest that you send your child with a bottle of water, preferably a disposable one (no fizzy drinks) and a warm hat for the walk to the centre. Please make sure that everything is labelled with your child's name. They will need to take suitable walking clothes onto the bus with them and not pack them in their bags as the bags are unloaded from the coach and transported to the centre separately. PLEASE can children be prepared for the walk to the Robinwood Centre (Alston is much colder than Ulverston).

Please do NOT send sweets for the journey as they are not allowed on the coach.

Please do NOT send mobile phones or electronic games. We cannot be held responsible for their loss or damage. There is no mobile phone reception at the centre and there will be no time to play games during our visit. A book or comic is recommended for the 10 minutes of quiet time before lights out.



The journey to the centre is on winding roads and games on the bus often cause travel sickness, even if your child is not usually susceptible. Children do not require a packed lunch as all meals and healthy snacks are provided. They should arrive at the pick-up point dressed in clothing and footwear suitable for a country walk, no jeans please.

Please, please, please make sure that ALL items in your child's case/bag are named. It really does help us while we are away and ensures that all belongings are returned to the owner.

Finally, if all goes according to plan, we should arrive back at SJB on Wednesday 21st January between 3.30pm and 4:00pm.
